

RULES AND REGULATIONS GENERAL

1. All exhibits, including animals, will be shown on both Saturday and Sunday. **Animal exhibits** will be accepted Friday between 4:00 – 5:30pm and after 7:30 pm and both **animal and agricultural** exhibits on Saturday between 7:00am – 9:00am. **Exhibits must be arranged by 9:00A.M. Saturday, and must remain intact until 5:00 P.M. Sunday.** Any exhibit removed before 5:00pm will forfeit premium money.
2. Anyone wishing to enter an exhibit should fill out an entry blank and send it in by **September 1st**. Please make all entries at one time. **Pre-registration is recommended** to avoid confusion. There is a limited amount of cages and pens for animal exhibits. Space is reserved as applications are received. For further information, see page 2 of this book for contact numbers.
3. The officers of The Wapping Fair will use all due precaution for the safety of goods on exhibition, but in no case will they be responsible for injury, loss or damage to any person, exhibit or personal property.
4. Exhibitors must in all cases give personal attention to delivery and removal of their exhibits:
 - (a.) Exhibitors must arrange their own exhibits for judging. The committee will not arrange untended materials for exhibit.
 - (b.) All exhibits, including foods, vegetables and flowers, not removed by 6:00 P.M. Sunday will be considered as donated to Wapping Fair and may be disposed of in any manner deemed fit by the fair committee.
5. Agricultural articles must have been produced by the exhibitor, and works of art must have been made by the exhibitor, within the last 12 months. All livestock must have been owned or managed by the exhibitor at least six months prior to the fair or, if less than six months of age, must be the offspring of livestock owned or managed by the exhibitor for six months prior to the fair. Current year 4-H projects are eligible and not restricted by the 6 month rule.
6. No person will be allowed to interfere with the judges when in the discharge of their duties. Only judges and fair staff will be allowed into the agricultural tent during judging.
7. No person will be allowed to act as judge in any department in which he himself is a competitor.
8. An exhibit tag showing the name of article, department and exhibitor's name must be attached to every article exhibited. Exhibit tags will be provided.
9. Lots that have fewer than 3 entries may be combined with other lots of a similar nature at superintendent's discretion.
10. (a) Entries of special merit not mentioned in any class will be given awards at the discretion of the judges.
(b) When there is little or no competition the awarding of a premium will be at the discretion of the judges. The Wapping Fair reserves the right to pay second money in all classes, if necessary. All decisions of the judges are final.
