

CLASS 3 - J JUNIOR CANNING

1. All exhibits must be in standard quart or pint canning jars, except jellies and jams, which should be in standard jelly glasses.
2. Collections must consist of at least the minimum number of jars indicated. Entries not meeting this minimum will be disqualified. The same jars may not be entered as both individual jars and as part of a collection.
3. Exhibitors may, if they wish, place their exhibitor number only on the bottom of each jar. If metal caps are used, the number may be placed on the cap. The exhibitor's name should not appear on the jar.
4. Lots that have fewer than 3 entries may be combined with other lots of a similar nature at superintendent's discretion.

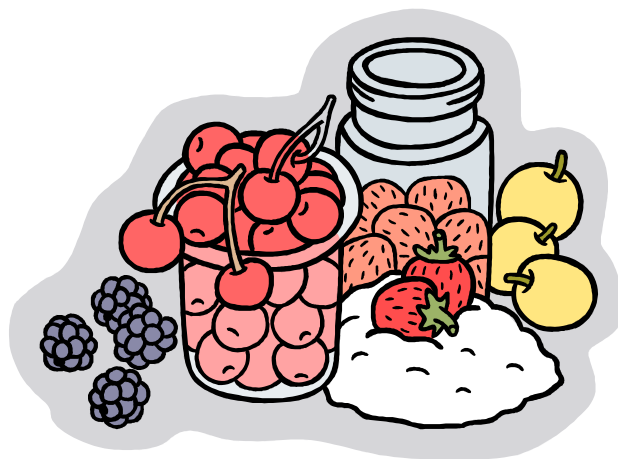
