

**CLASS 1
ADULT VEGETABLES**

1. All exhibits must consist of exactly the number of specimens or varieties indicated. Exhibits containing less than the required number will be disqualified.
2. The same specimens may not be entered as both individual vegetables and as part of a collection. They may, however, be entered in both Biggest and Tallest (Section B) and Individual Vegetables (Section C).
3. In Section C, exhibitors may enter only one plate of each variety, but may exhibit up to 3 varieties in any one lot. Four or more varieties must be entered as a collection in Section A. Please specify varieties of all individual plates on entry form.
4. All vegetables should be in prime market condition. The quality of vegetable does not necessarily depend on its size.
5. Collections will be judged on the following scorecard:

Attractiveness of Arrangement	35 points
Quality of Vegetables	35 points
Number of Varieties or Vegetables	30 points
6. Lots that have fewer than 3 entries may be combined with other lots of a similar nature at superintendent's discretion.

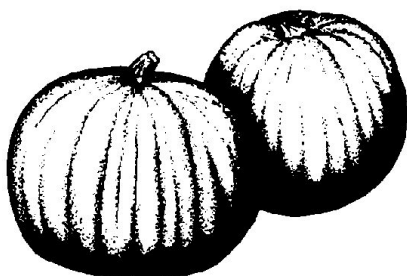
1. Vegetable Collection - 8 or more different vegetables. Different varieties of the same vegetable may be included in the exhibit but will count as only one of the required eight vegetables.
2. Herb Collection - One small bouquet of 5 or more different herbs, fresh or dried. All specimens must be labeled.
3. Pepper Collection - 3 specimens each of 4 or more different varieties of peppers.
4. Tomato Collection - 3 specimens each of 4 or more different varieties of tomatoes, all sizes included.
5. Summer Squash Collection - 2 specimens each of 4 or more different varieties of summer squash. Do not include winter squash.
6. Winter Squash Collection - 2 specimens each of 4 or more different varieties of winter squash. Do not include summer squash or pumpkins.
7. Collection of any other vegetable - 3 specimens each of 4 or more different varieties of any one vegetable not listed above

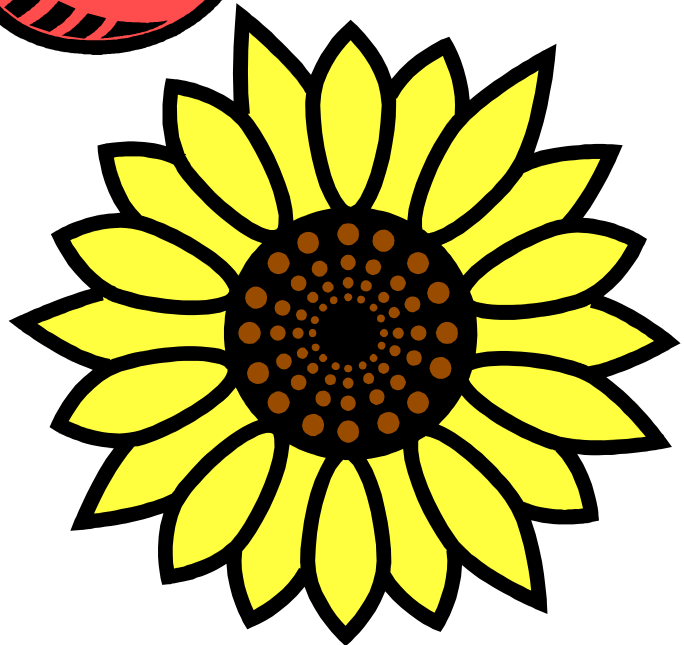
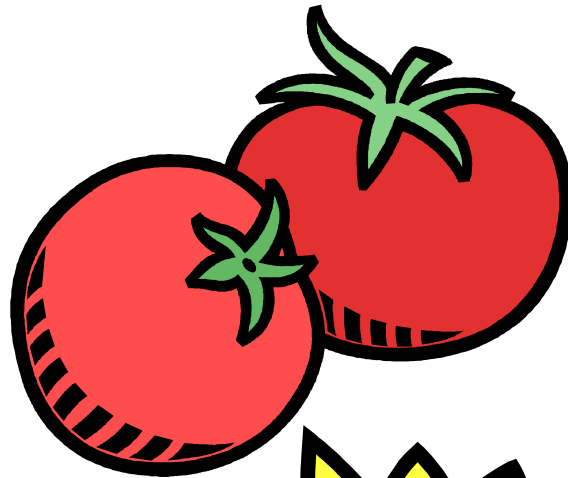
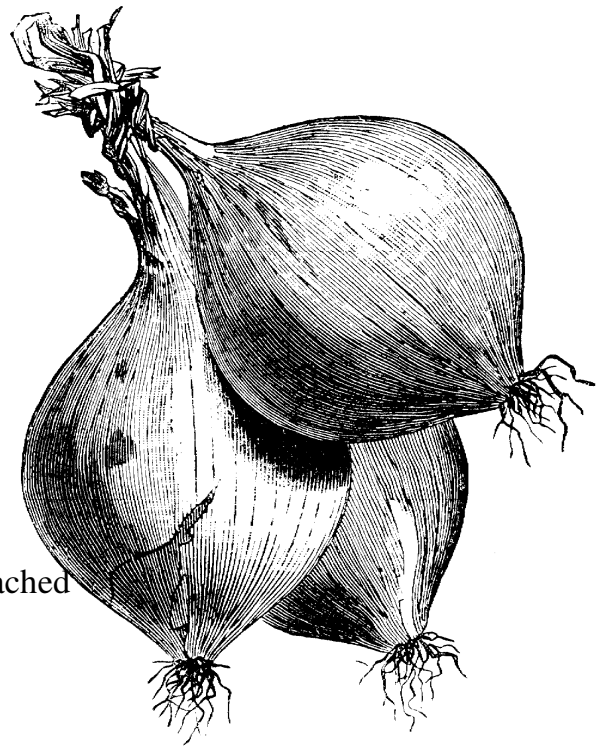
